About the Position Position Summary

The Education Coordinator will be responsible for conducting bicycle and pedestrian safety related events for Bike Walk Golden Isles (BWGI), a 501-c3 organization dedicated to improving safety and opportunities for residents and visitors of the Golden Isles area of Georgia to bike, walk and roll. This is a newly created position funded through the Georgia Office of Highway Safety, and the Education Coordinator will work directly with the BWGI Executive Director and BWGI Board of Directors. As a plank holder for this new position, the person filling this role will have a unique opportunity to create, plan, promote and execute events at both small- and large-scale levels with a focus on bike and pedestrian safety, traffic laws, and more.

The Education Coordinator will need certification as a League Cycling Instructor through the League of American Bicyclists within the first year of hire. This is a 20-hour per week position with flexible working hours, some weekend and evening requirements, and limited instate travel opportunities.

Core Duties and Responsibilities

Plan, organize and conduct bicycle and pedestrian safety events in consultation with BWGI Executive Director.

Prepare written materials for public distribution including bicycle and pedestrian safety guides and maps.

Post information on bike and pedestrian safety tips and events on social media platforms for BWGI. Create and distribute news releases regarding BWGI safety related events.

Attend community events to promote BWGI and its mission.

Assist with preparation of grant applications and necessary reports to support existing grants.

Become knowledgeable of tools for identifying bicycle and pedestrian accidents as well as injury and fatality statistics.

Maintain and improve knowledge of current bicycle and pedestrian related issues by participating in regional and national professional training sessions, conferences, webinars and independent study opportunities.
